DAMIAN DUNCAN currently serves as CIO and Lead Independent Director of ISP Finance Services Limited, a JSE Listed Micro-Credit Company and also a Partner/Investor at Sage Global Finance LLC, a Barbados-based Financial Advisory and Private Equity Firm focused on investing in high-growth opportunities across the Caribbean, specifically technologically driven and enabled logistics service businesses as well as alternative financing companies.

From 2020-2021 he managed the Fintech business of Supreme Ventures Group where he was responsible for the establishment and execution of fintech strategy as well as the rollout of financial solutions that create value for customers and stakeholders alike.

Prior to this, he was an Assistant General Manager at NCB Financial Group responsible for Mergers & Acquisitions. In this role, he was responsible for identifying and evaluating M&A opportunities domestically and across the region, as well as efficient capital allocation and deployment for transactions. He was instrumental in all aspects of NCB's acquisition of a majority stake in Trinidad-based Guardian Holdings, a transaction valued at over USD\$500 million as well as NCB's majority stake in Clarien Bank (Bermuda), valued at over USD\$100 million.

In addition to his professional pursuits, he is an avid investor and shareholder in multiple early and mid-stage technology-focused companies in the region and South-Eastern United States. He is a principal shareholder in Dryv Group (dryva.app), a technology platform providing transportation and courier solutions in Jamaica and Bahamas.

Earlier in his professional life, Damian spent 9 years on Wall St. at various firms, most recently as a Vice-President in the Asset Optimization Group at Bank of America Merrill Lynch, responsible for managing the short-term funding and collateral management needs. Previously, Damian worked with the Alternative Assets Group at Merrill Lynch, an internal, principal investment vehicle focused on asset classes ranging from middle market private equity and commercial real estate to insurance and asset-based lending.
